How to Whitelist Our Emails (Avoid Spam)

Our emails sometimes land in Spam/Junk. To always receive appointment reminders, lab results, and important updates, please add our email address to your Safe Senders list.

Quick Tip (All Clients): If you already have an email from us in Spam/Junk, open it and click **Not Spam / Not Junk**. Then add us to Contacts.

Gmail (Web or App)

1. Open Gmail → click gear icon → **See all settings**
2. Go to **Filters and Blocked Addresses** tab → **Create a new filter**
3. In **From** field enter: **info@schreibervet.com**
4. Click **Create filter** → check **Never send it to Spam** → Create filter

Also: Add the email address to your Google Contacts.

Outlook.com / Hotmail / Outlook App

Web (outlook.com / office.com):

1. Settings (gear) → **Mail** → **Junk email**
2. Under **Safe senders and domains** click **+ Add safe sender**
3. Enter the email address → OK → Save

Desktop Outlook: Home tab → Junk → Junk E-mail Options → Safe Senders tab → Add

Yahoo Mail

1. Open Spam folder → open our email → click **Not Spam**
2. Settings (gear) → **More Settings** → **Filters** → **Add new filters**
3. Name it "Schreiber Vet" → From: enter the email address → Deliver to **Inbox** → Save

Also add the email address to your Yahoo Contacts.

Apple Mail (iPhone, iPad, Mac) / iCloud

iPhone/iPad: Open Mail → go to Junk → swipe left on our email → Mark → **Not Junk**

Then open the email → tap the sender name → **Create New Contact** (or Add to Existing)

Mac: Select the email → click **Not Junk** in toolbar. Or Mail → Preferences → Rules → Add Rule for the From address.

Best: Add the email to your Contacts app (syncs across devices).

Other Clients (AOL, Proton, etc.)

- Mark any message from us as **Not Spam / Not Junk**
- Add **info@schreibervet.com** to your address book/contacts
- Look for "Safe Senders", "Allow List", "Filters", or "Rules" in Settings
